**PARENTAL PARTICIPATION**

The LOGOS Program enables parents to fulfill a portion of the basic responsibilities set by God for them in the raising of their children. Parents are to take an active role in their children’s lives and are to assist their children with any assignments, encourage their regular participation, and nurture their faith and growth in the Christian life.

**In Deuteronomy 6:7 it says:**

***“Impress (these commandments) on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.”***

Active participation by at least one parent of every child in LOGOS is requested. Since almost all the staff is volunteer, part time service by a large number of people is essential to keep the many activities going. At least as important, however, is the “moral boosting” effect of the parent’s physical presence and visible support of the program from time to time. This is a vital element in the successful operation of the LOGOS program. There are many opportunities for parental participation, most of which offer great fellowship, and some of which can be done at home or with little time commitment.

At the time of registration, either one or both parents will be given the opportunity to fill out a Volunteer Sign-up Sheet indicating how they would like to be involved. Many opportunities are available, with a wide variety of time commitments.
